Aids is there a way out?

Aids {Acquired immunodeficiency syndrome} was first recognized in 1981 in the United States of America as a new disease of unknown origin.

Every 25 seconds someone is being infected with HIV (the human immunodeficiency virus) the virus causes AIDS. HIV is found in the fluid exchange during sexual intercourse (men's semen and women vaginal fluids). HIV is spreading at an increasing rate in almost every country.

Aids invade the world!

It is estimated that over 36 million are infected and another 22 million have died from the effects of AIDS.

Aids invade Africa,

with an estimated 25.3 million infected. In this region alone, 2.4 million died from the effects of AIDS. Here 5,000 babies are born HIV positive every month.

In Nigeria, AIDS is cutting deeper than we imagine, when the country is placed third in Africa. With 5.4 million Nigerians already living with the virus, it is estimated that the next three years, another 1 million Nigerians youths would have been infected.

Nigeria with an infant mortality rate of about 11 per 1000 live births, is sitting on a ticking AIDS time bomb with a current prevalence rate of 5.8% HIV sero-positively when a population of about 120 million people.

Nigeria presents a perfect comfort zone for AIDS, more than most African countries. The country represents the ideal climate for unchecked AIDS.

Many people wonder why they get infected and most of them say it is not fair! Why me... I have only had sex with one person until recently it was reckoned that men and women, on the average had sex with different people in their lifetimes.

And those sexes partner with thirty-six more.... So one person could receive sexually transmitted disease {STDs} from up to 40,000 people, it only needs one person to pass an infection.

Liberty4Africa encourage you to engage in the following practice.

Engage in safe sex.

Avoid pre-marital sex, staying a virgin till marriage and marrying uninfected partner, staying to one partner.

Lower risk

Sex outside of marriage using a condom or non- penetrative sex. Do not place 100% faith on condom.

As a birth control device they have a failure rate of between 10 and 30%. Why should we trust them to protect us any better from AIDS or other STDs?

Higher risk

Sex outside of marriage without a condom. {How can you be sure of your partner faith}? Not following condom instruction before use. Performing oral sex without special Tips for safe oral sex.

Very high risk.

Sex without condom with an infected partner or partners.

L4A we appreciate everyone to:

1 Curbing the spread of the dreaded disease by encouraging people to confirm your status by going for HIV/AIDS confirmatory test so that those who are positive would stop spread the virus.

2 Informing youths about this disease and its penalties, also educating them on how to practice safe sex, the need to buy use condoms, and possibly avoid sex before marriage, whereby lowering the risk of contacting STDs – chancroids, chlamydeous, public {crabs} Gonorrhoea, herpes A – E, human papilla virus, scabies, syphilis and HIV/AIDS.

3 Getting people to appreciate the fact that person living with AIDS or are HIV positive are still entitle to their right in the society.

4 Let the citizen know that the disease is no respect of class and that its treatment is class base, because it is only the rich that afford the current rate of about \$200 {#30,000} monthly for a cocktail antiretroviral drugs.
